Mustache and Cleavage is Alexander Lewis and Amy Kelly. The two long-time friends share a common interest in writing American folk-pop songs that are emotional and easily relatable. Their musical partnership started out several years ago, and they had just begun playing out when the world came to a standstill in 2020. Now that things have opened up again, the two are raring to pick right back up where they left off, armed with a bevy of new Mustache and Cleavage material that combines drama and humor to round out one hell of a listening experience!

The singer-songwriter duo creates exciting music built on a strong aesthetic, enabling the audience to fully immerse themselves into the sound, musically and conceptually. On stage, the band delivers compelling stories and memorable melodies with two voices and an acoustic guitar.

To date, the duo has released two studio EPs: “Can of Tears” in 2019 and, at the height of the pandemic, “Sheltering Songs” in 2020. These records are a great introduction to Mustache and Cleavage’s incredibly diverse sound and its distinctive formula of ringing harmonies, heartbreaking lyrics, and a dash of humor. Mustache and Cleavage’s track “Unicorn” was featured in the film *What's the Matter with Gerald?*, which won the 2016 Cinema Diverse award.
